FOCUS ON A FAVORITE SUBJECT AREA

Interdisciplinary concentrations require 30 credit hours, with 12 from upper-level courses.

Possibilities include English language arts and writing, environmental studies, humanities, mathematics, social sciences and urban studies.

EXPERIENCE IS THE BEST TEACHER

Cortland teacher candidates gain nearly 250 hours of observation and practice teaching experience connected to coursework. A semester of student teaching includes two, eight-week placements at two different schools and grade levels.

Students also benefit from an annual Teacher Recruitment Day, a career-focused event that takes place on campus in the spring and draws school districts from across the country.
